

OCRA INCIDENT MATRIX GUIDELINES

| Incident | Call | Rowing and Paddling Characteristics | Incident Report |
|----------|---------------------------------|---|-----------------|
| MAJOR | 911 and OCRA Head Coach on cell | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capsize or swamp in safety zones 3-6 Rowing, 2-5 Paddling. • Collision with non-OCRA powered vessels or rowing shells • Any situations requiring immediate medical attention such as loss of consciousness, significant bleeding, etc. Applies to all safety | REQUIRED |
| MODERATE | OCRA Head Coach on cell | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capsize or swamp in zones 1 and 2 Rowing, zone 1 Paddling. • Collision among OCRA boats • “Near-miss” events due to poor judgment, equipment issue, unexpected weather conditions, etc. • Injuries requiring first aid attention but not a medical emergency | AS NEEDED |
| MINOR | Coach decision | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incident resulting in minor equipment damage (Repair sheet must be completed) • Minor injuries outside of the expected injuries from rowing or paddling such as blisters, scrapes, calf bites, etc. | AS NEEDED |

Note: When calling 911 please let them know if you want River Rescue. Call OCRA Head Coach on any incident that involves 911 or the media.
